



SOLAR POWER UP AND RUNNING AT HOLY FAMILY!



Holy Family's new 185-kilowatt solar system began generating clean electric power on February 9th. This system will generate an estimated 275,000 kilowatt hours of electricity each year, which equates to roughly two-thirds of the electricity used at the Holy Family Parish & School buildings each year. Through May 23rd, the 1,056 solar panels that comprise the system have produced in excess of 86,000 kilowatt hours of electricity. As we move into the sunny summer months, the amount of power generated each day will increase.
