Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation will be registered in a Parish Formation program that leads them to a deeper understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist enabling them to participate actively in the Sunday Liturgy. Candidates will become more closely aware of the presence of Christ in the assembly, the president, the Word and in a special way, the Eucharistic elements. Candidates will be introduced to the major symbols of the sacrament and reflect on their meaning. All candidates will be involved in opportunities for reflection, prayer and retreat. The sacrament of Penance will be encouraged and offered, especially in the season of Lent. The apostolic work of the baptized will be encouraged and candidates will be introduced to opportunities to join the parish community in living out this life of service, both within and without the parish.

Pastoral practice presumes that persons requesting the sacrament are persons of goodwill and ask to celebrate Confirmation with a basic attitude of faith. The community, represented by the Confirmation catechists and Faith Formation team, will make recommendations to the pastor as to the readiness of the candidates who present for Confirmation after a period of preparation. The Parish priest or his delegate will meet individually with each candidate during this time as he must make the final discernment in the candidate's readiness to celebrate the sacrament. This is discerned by the candidate's attitude, values, practice and understanding of the sacraments. (Per San Jose Diocese Policy on Confirmation, approved June 13, 2002)
